We are looking for legal professionals from civil society organisations or engaged in civil society activities from the Russian Federation who speak fluent English and focus on Environmental Law & Public Participation.

We provide:

- Reimbursement of travel costs contribution for accommodation (up to 600 EUR/month) and living expenses (up to 600 EUR/month)
- Professional guidance at the host institution
- Assistance with logistics

We require:

- CV and motivation letter in English language (maximum: 2 pages)
- Proposal of the project, which would be developed during the fellowship (maximum: 1 page)
- Suggestion of the topic for the article at Legal Dialogue Journal (maximum: ½ page)
